Bible Study

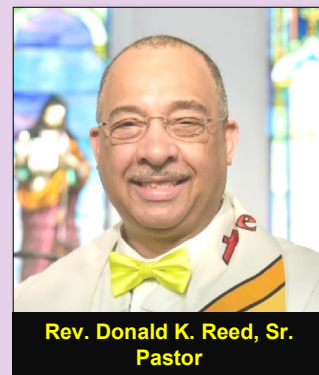
Join the Wednesday night Lenten Bible Study Class. Study is based on the book, "Plenty Good Room". For information to join, see the announcement on the email link or call the church office.

Millions of Christians will celebrate Easter Sunday this month, after the 40-day period (not including Sundays) known as Lent.

The most common dates Easter occurred or will occur between 1600 and 2099 is March 31 or April 16.

Easter Sunday always occurs on the first Sunday following the full Moon that occurs on or after the March or spring equinox.

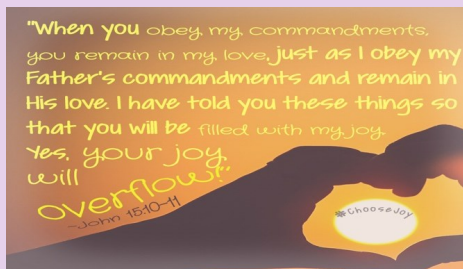

- After your interest form has been reviewed and approved by your sponsoring representative, you will be contacted by your representative's office confirming which of your three requested dates has been selected for you to page.
