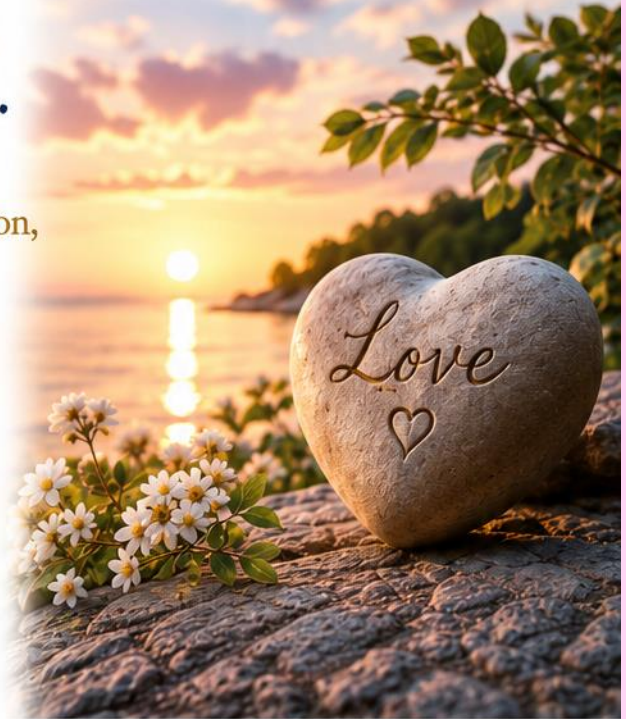


Living from Love, Leading with Compassion,

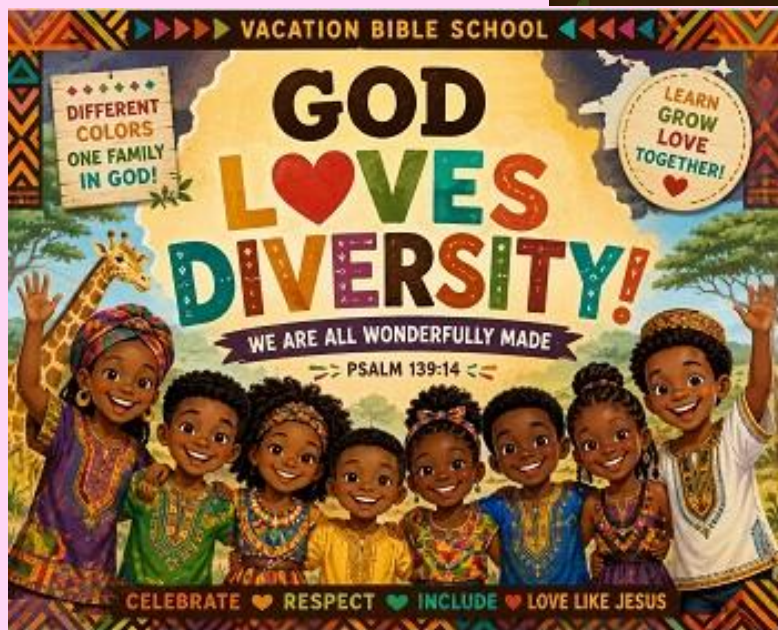

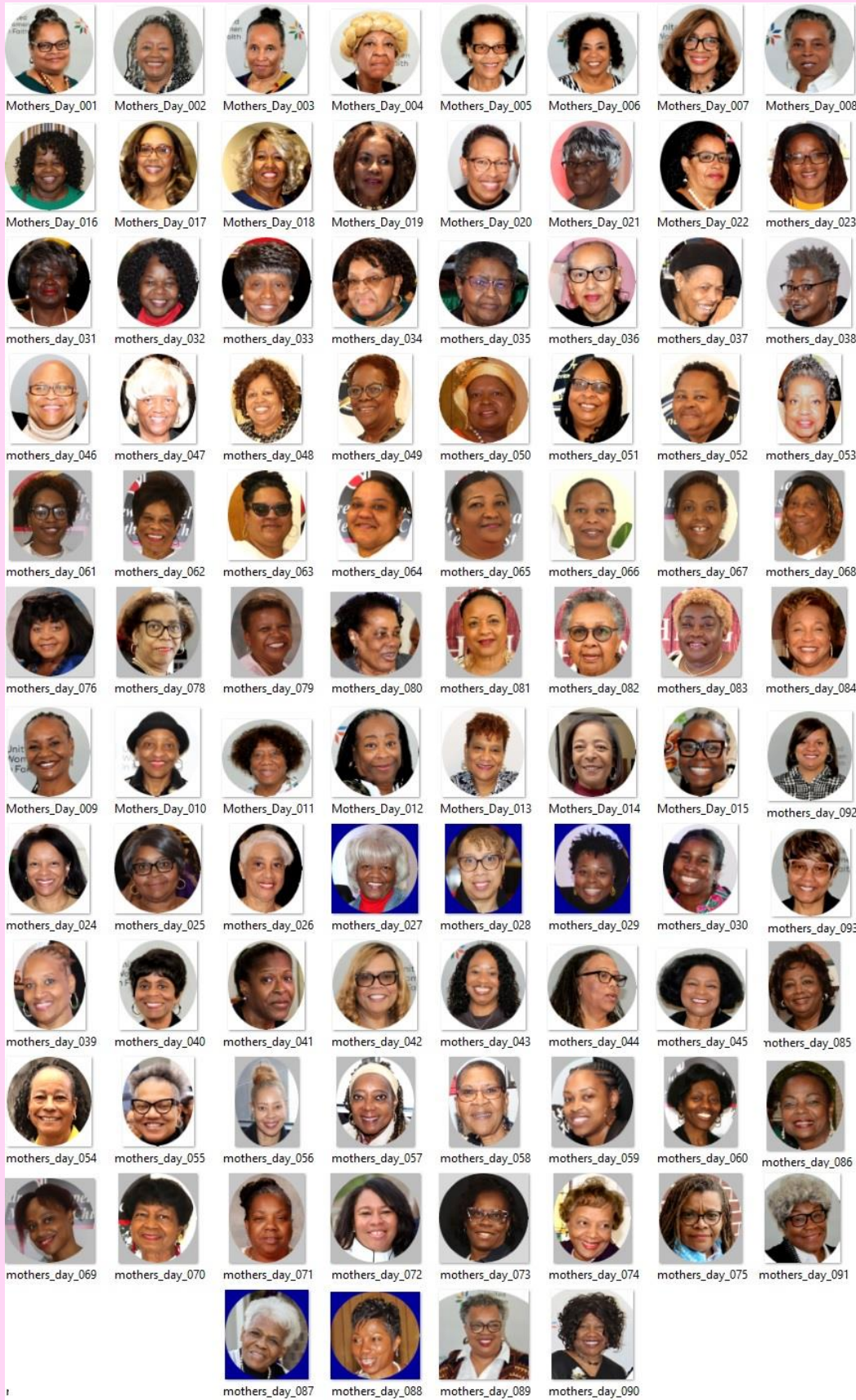

Major June Holidays & Observances (2026)

- **Flag Day (June 14):** Commemorates the adoption of the U.S. flag in 1777.
- **Juneteenth (June 19):** A federal holiday commemorating the emancipation of enslaved African Americans.
- **Father's Day (June 21):** Celebrated on the third Sunday of June to honor fathers and father figures.

Key Monthly Themes - Cultural & Awareness Months

- **Juneteenth Atlanta Festival:** Taking place at Georgia State University (Atlanta campus) from June 19-21, featuring a parade, live music, and family-friendly cultural events.
- **Pride Month:** Honors the LGBTQ+ community, commemorating the 1969 Stonewall riots.
- **Men's Mental Health Awareness Month:** Raises awareness about men's unique mental health challenges and aims to reduce the stigma around seeking help.
- **National Caribbean-American Heritage Month:** Recognizes the contributions of Caribbean immigrants to the United States.

Fun/Random Holidays

- **National Doughnut Day (June 5):** Celebrated annually on the first Friday in June.
- **D-Day Anniversary (June 6):** Marks the historic Allied invasion of Normandy in 1944.
- **National Go Barefoot Day (June 1):** A quirky awareness day often tied to charity campaigns.

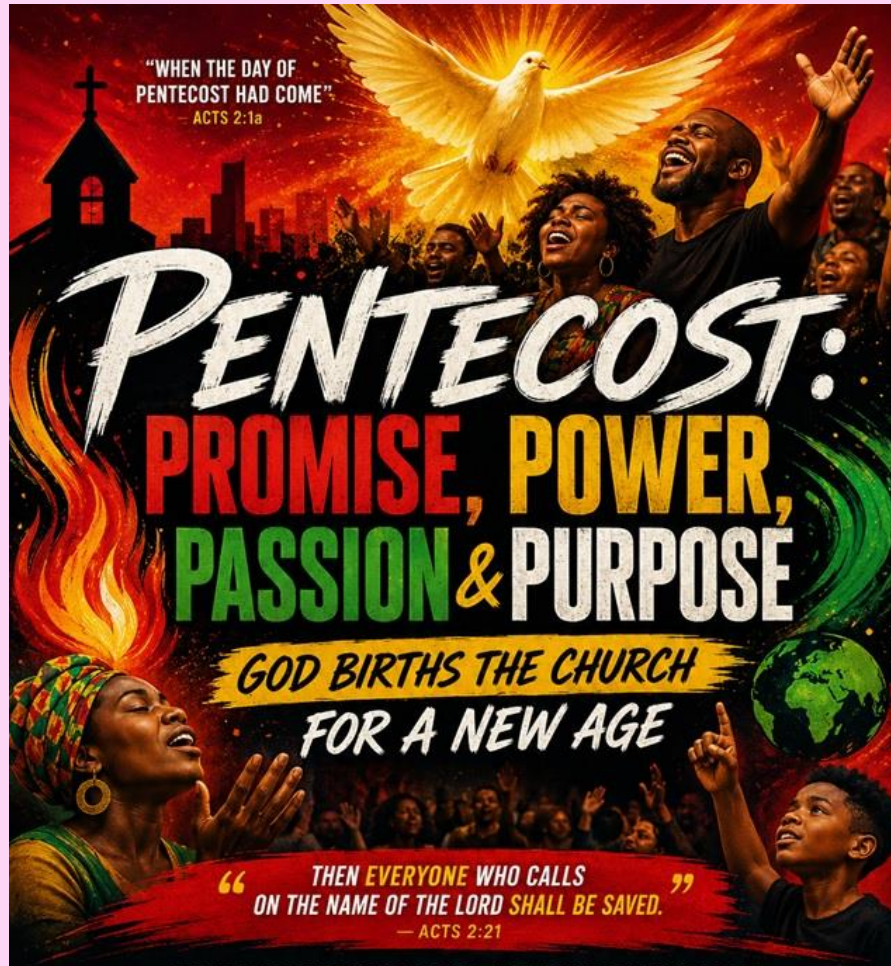

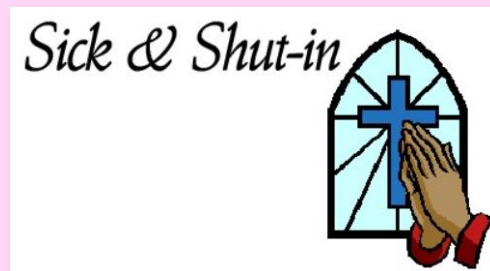

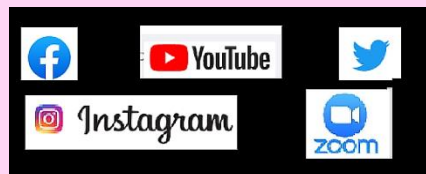
